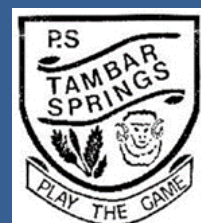

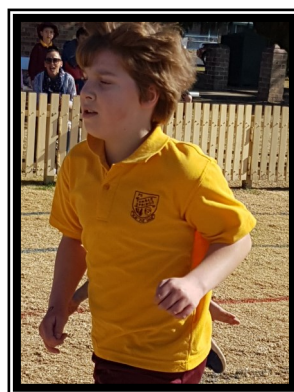


CONGRATULATIONS
